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## PLANNING INFORMATIONG

### Pathfinder Teen Retreat 2018

#### **PURPOSE OF TEEN RETREAT**

- The retreat is structured and programmed for teens to make new friends with other teens from around the Conference.
- Teen Retreat is intended to support club staff by helping equip their teens with ministry and outreach skills that they can take back to the club to teach to junior Pathfinders.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

- All Teens in grades 8-12 are encouraged to attend with their club staff.
- Teens in grade 7 & 13yrs old or older are invited subject to the Club Director's approval.
- A signed Permission and Medical Consent Form must be on site for each person under 18.
- Because this weekend is an intensive training weekend and there is no programming for younger children, it is encouraged that they do not attend.

#### FRIDAY AND SABBATH PROGRAM - Living Life in Another Culture & Economic Status

Please note that this program will require all participants to stay for the first 24 hours without leaving. The program is called "In Their Steps" and it is an opportunity for our young people to experience the challenges other young people face in different cultures. This opportunity will be experienced through our meals, accommodations, and activities. You will be experiencing teens' lives in other countries that may or may not be of the same economic status.

We understand if you must leave before the 24 hours are up, we would ask that you return at the end of the first 24 hours and participate for the remainder of the weekend.

Please do not spoil your teens experience by feeding them before they arrive to the event.

#### **SUNDAY - MISSIONS**

Sunday will be our day for Mission outreach training. We will be offering a variety of opportunities, so the Teen Pathfinders will have choices.

**Balloon Art** - Learn to use balloons for sharing with children on outreach projects.

Fleece Blankets - Making blankets to give to those in need

Making scarves – to put in children and soldier boxes

Packing Shoe Boxes for children – these will be shipped all over the world

Puppet ministry – Learning how to use puppets for sharing Jesus

Engine Repair - What to do when the car quits and there are no local repair shops

Making cookies for soldiers' boxes

Packing Care boxes for Soldiers

Ice Breaker Games – A great way to mix with people of other cultures and share Jesus

Making Pillow Case dresses to send to orphan children

Making crafts for Care Boxes – children and soldier boxes.

Packing buckets for Disaster relief. – Packing buckets with items needed for Disaster

These are some of the classes we have planned. In about 2 weeks you will get a final list so your Teen Pathfinders can put down their 3 choices. This will give us the opportunity to get them placed into classes ahead of time. If you have questions, contact Carolyn Betlinski
