



Pathfinder Teen Canoe Trip

Where: Aldrich Point with lodging at Scappoose Adventist Academy Friday night

Who: All Oregon Teen Pathfinders (7th grade and up)

Cost and Registration:

The cost is \$45 per person before October 2, the registration deadline. This includes Friday night lodging, equipment rental and meals Friday night and Sabbath morning. After October 2, the cost is \$55.00 per person and includes an added \$10.00 late fee.

Consent & Release Form:

As with all Pathfinder events, a valid Permission and Medical Consent Form must accompany each Pathfinder.

What to bring:

- Pack Sabbath lunch, dinner and Sunday breakfast - as they are not provided
- Teen Pathfinders and at least one staff for every four Pathfinders.
- Sleeping bag and personal items.
- Shoes that you can get wet.
- Synthetic clothes that dry quickly and a swimsuit for underneath (You might will get wet). Fleece, polyester, or nylon are good choices. Don't wear cotton!
- Water bottle on a rope, sunscreen, hat, etc. Prepare to be outside all day.
- Dry clothes and a towel.
- Plastic Bags and big black garbage bag or dry bag for all gear inside duffel
- Toiletries
- Tent for Saturday night
- Water or water filtration

Weekend in a Nutshell:

Pathfinder clubs will meet at Scappoose Adventist School on Friday evening for registration at 6:00pm, but not before (Clubs cannot arrive before 6pm). Dinner will be provided and after dinner there will be activities. In the morning breakfast will be provided and then we will drive to Aldrich Point and canoe to the island in the beautiful Columbia River where we will be spending Saturday night.
